**Valentines card and letter to Jessie Shearer from W. Robinson, 13
February 1849 (GD121/4/1/1) from the Buchanan Family of Milton of
Campsie collection (GD121)**

Transcript:

'Maryhill 13th Febr 1849

My Dear Jessie,

Why have I delayed so long to write? Forgive me for this, and I will promise not to be guilty again.

I fondly anticipated seeing you ere this, but owing to my being rather unwell for some time prevented me, should nothing intervene, I will go to Lillyburn on Saturday first, I long to see my Dear Jessie, should I not get going, write me when you will be in Glasgow or at any rate write, saying if you will be at home on Saturday first, by the bye. You forgot to send me a valentine, now you must send it yet and I will give you one for it. I will expect to hear from my lovely Jessie by Thursday and tell me all the news.

I will if possible be in time for the train that leaves at half 4 o'clock if you have nothing to do you might come down to the Milton Station – I will anxiously await your coming and till then My Dear Jessie.
